

Installation and Fitting Instructions

Before you start

*It is essential that any surfaces of the unit which are cut during installation are re-sealed using an appropriate waterproof sealant, varnish or oil based paint. Failure to re-seal cut surfaces will invalidate the product warranty and may result in water damage.



- 1) Remove worktop by gently pulling it upwards. This is fixed with push fit clips.
- 2) Remove top fascia by gently pulling it forwards. This is fixed with push fit clips.
- 3) Remove main access panel by simply sliding upwards. This is fixed on sliding clips.

4) For standard BTW pan

- Fit base unit to wall in required location ensuring correct position of supply and waste pipes.
- Fit WC and cistern according to manufacturer's instructions check system carefully for leaks.
- Cut a suitable slot in the main access panel to allow for the soil pipe and inlet. Note: Cut this slot as wide as possible to make refitting the main access panel easier.
- Refit the panel by sliding it back into position. Silicone the join between WC and access panel.

4) For Wall hung pan and frame

- Fit base unit to wall in required location ensuring correct position of supply and waste pipes.
- Fix the frame to the floor and into a SOLID BRICK WALL (through the top brace of the BTW unit) as per instructions included with frame.
- Cut a suitable hole in the main access panel to allow for the soil pipe, inlet and wall hung pan bolts.
- Refit the panel by sliding it back into position.
- Fix WC and cistern according to manufacturer's instructions check system carefully for leaks.
- Silicone the join between WC and access panel.
- 5) Drill suitably positioned / diameter hole in the fascia for the cistern operating button and install according to manufacturers guidelines.
- 6) Re-fit fascia.
- 7) Re-fit worktop.

Furniture Aftercare Instructions

As with all wooden furniture, this unit should be treated with care:

We recommend...



Wipe away any water splashes or condensation after use. Excessive exposure to water will deteriorate the furniture.



All bathrooms should be well ventilated with a suitable extractor fan.



Clean with a soft damp cloth only.



Use a wax free polish if one must be used.

For removal of lime scale deposits use a suitable proprietary cleaner. If necessary test on an inconspicuous area first.

Do not use abrasive cleaning agents
