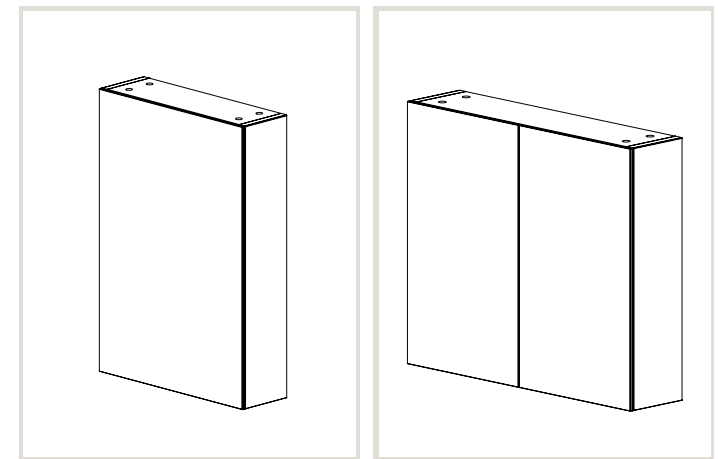

Installation Procedure

Important: Before starting the installation process, ensure the wall construction is suitable and can support the weight of the cabinet.

Note: The wall plugs supplied are suitable for solid stone / brick walls. For any other wall material use specialist wall plugs.

Step 1 - Preparing the cabinet

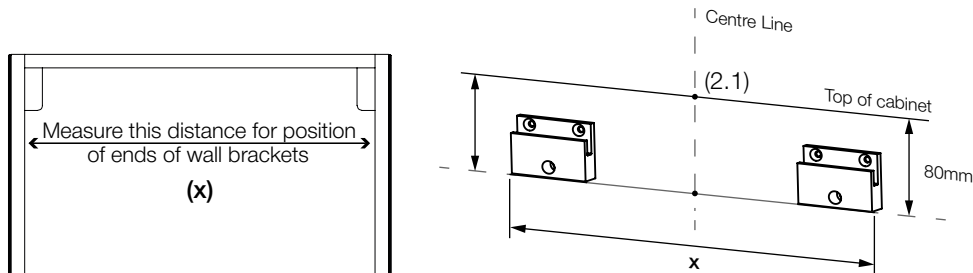
1.1 – Carefully place the cabinet upright on the floor on 1 honeycomb piece.

Step 2 - Installing the cabinet

2.1 – Using a pencil, mark on the wall where you wish the centre of the top surface of the cabinet to be (2.1).

2.2 – Measure 80mm vertically below this point and make a mark.

2.3 – Using a spirit level, draw a line of distance X centred on this point and parallel with the floor.

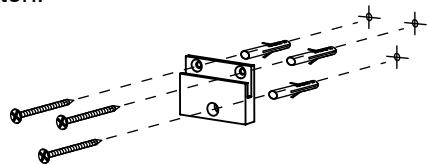


2.4 – Align the outer edge of the wall brackets with the ends of this line X.

2.5 – Using the wall brackets as a guide, mark the hole positions.

2.6 – Drill the marked holes and fit the wall plugs.

2.7 – Screw the wall brackets into place ensuring the screws are fully tightened but take care not to overtighten.



2.8 – Hang the cabinet on the wall brackets and check its level.

When cleaning the mirror or any mirrored surfaces it is recommended to use a soft, dry, non abrasive cloth with the mirror turned off. Do not use cleaning agents or abrasive materials.

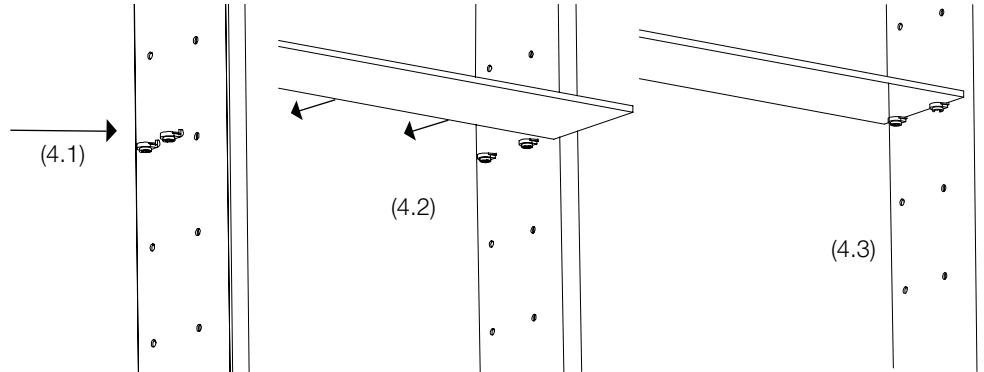
Installation Procedure

Step 4 (optional) - Changing the shelf spacing

4.1 – Push the shelf supports at the desired height. (4.1).

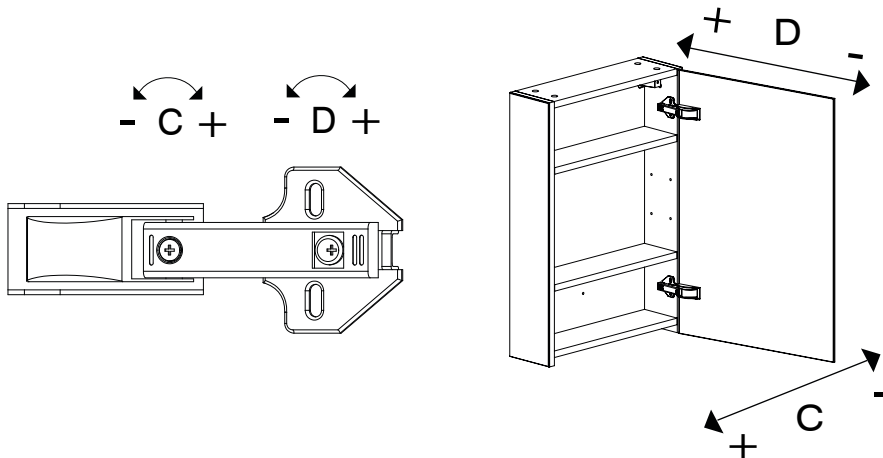
4.2 – Slide the shelf on to the shelf supports (4.2).

4.3 – Repeat steps 4.1 to 4.2 for the remaining shelves.

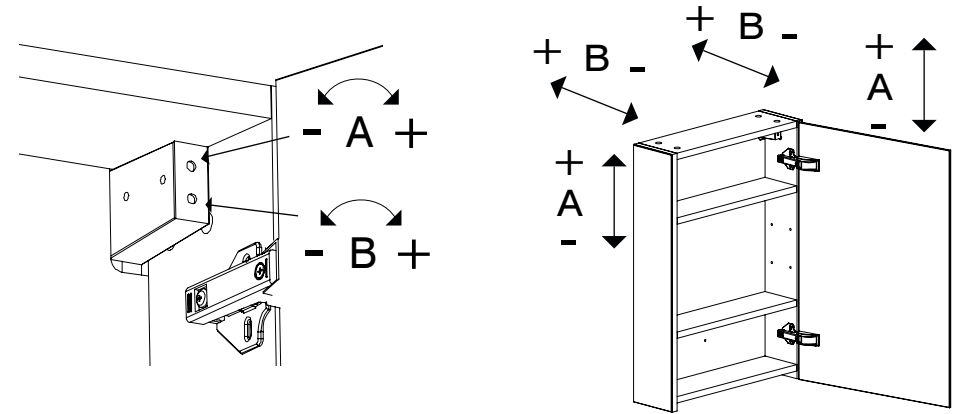


Step 5 - Door Alignment

5.1 – Adjust the cabinet doors using the adjustment screws on the hinges. As shown below.



Installation Procedure



2.9 – When the cabinet is level, mark the hole on the lower section of the cabinet backboard (2.9). Take the cabinet off the wall.

2.10 – Drill and fit the wall plug into the hole just marked.

Step 3 - Finishing the installation

3.1 – Hang the cabinet on the wall brackets and tighten screw B. This will pull the cabinet closer to the wall.

3.2 – Screw in the internal securing screw (3.2).
