
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


This pan is to be used with a concealed cistern. Please refer to the cistern manufacturer's instructions for fitting information.

It is recommended that the back to wall pan is first positioned in the desired installation area and its final position marked faintly with a pencil. This is to ensure that the pan can be located quickly and all necessary fittings can be positioned correctly.

- 1. Position the floor fittings, flush pipe from the concealed cistern and the soil pipe as shown in the diagram. Ensure that the flush pipe is trimmed to the correct length to fit info the inlet of the pan.
- 2. Connect the cistern inlet into the back of the pan and connect the soil pipe before aligning the pan with the fixing brackets on the floor. It is important that the fixing brackets are perfectly aligned and that the pan sits flush with the wall.
- 3. Secure the pan to the floor fixing brackets with the fittings provided.
