## Instructions:

## Changing the Frame

Important: Product must be turn off and isolated from the power supply before performing maintenance.

Important: Do not use a drill to undo the screws as it could damage them. Use a handheld Phillips screwdriver

1) Remove the mirror from the wall and disconnect the power supply.
2) Place the mirror on a protective surface with the mirror side down.
3) Disconnect the LEDs from the power connector.

4) Remove the screws on the metal brackets that connect the frame to the brackets.

5) Remove the mirror, brackets and electronics box from the frame (they should all be bonded together).
6) Place the mirror into the new frame and connect the LEDs to the power connector
7) Screw the frame to the brackets
8) Connect the mirror to the mains power supply and hang it on the wall.
