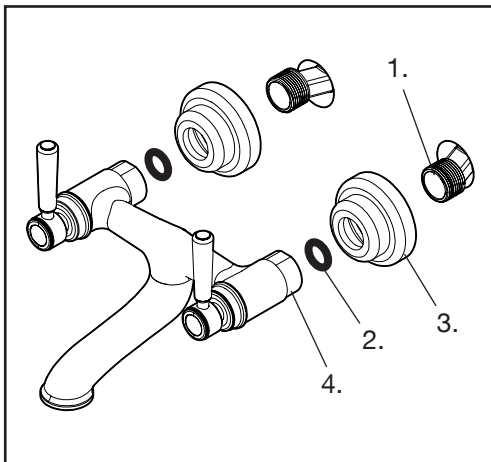
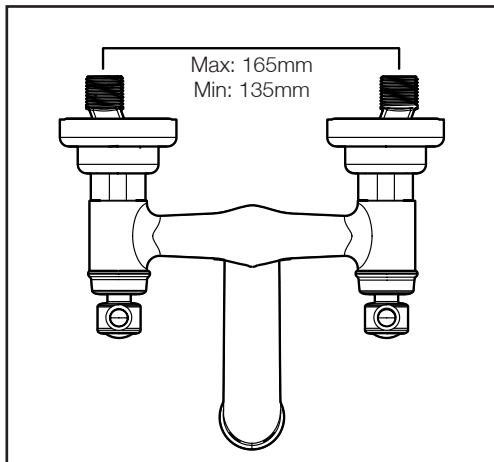


BATH FILLER / BATH SHOWER MIXER WALL MOUNTING KIT - INSTRUCTIONS

Taps shown are for illustrative purposes only and may not match the specific product you have purchased, though installation methods are identical. Please retain these instructions for future reference.

IMPORTANT: Most problems associated with the operation of new installations are caused by debris in the new pipe work getting into the product. These problems are easily avoided by thoroughly flushing the pipe work **BEFORE** the product is fitted.



1. The offset threaded connectors included with this product are intended to be used with 15mm pipework. Install hot and cold inlets to the desired installation location. The fixing nut centres on the bath filler body are 150mm apart.

2. Attach the offset threaded connectors (1.) to the pipework using the G1/2" threaded end. The hole centres can be positioned between 135mm and 165mm apart to allow for some adjustment if your pipework is slightly off. Adjust the threaded connectors so that the bath filler / bath shower mixer body can be assembled onto the G3/4" threads.

Note: The use of PTFE tape is recommended on all threaded connections to ensure a watertight seal.

3. Insert the two rubber washers (2.) supplied into the threaded connectors on the bath filler / bath shower mixer and assemble the cover shroud (3.) onto the offset threaded connector until it is flush with the wall.

4. Mount the bath filler / bath shower mixer to the threaded connector using the swivel nuts (4.) Do not overtighten as this may damage the washers. Check the system for leaks before completing installation.

AFTERCARE INSTRUCTIONS

Whilst this item has a high quality durable finish, it should nevertheless be treated with care. Surfaces should be cleaned using only a soft damp cloth and clean water & dried using a soft cotton cloth. Do not use an abrasive material such as a brush or scouring pad to clean the surface. The use of abrasive cleaners, alcohol or disinfectants will alter the surface finish and void the warranty.

Do not allow products such as toothpaste, shaving cream, drain and glass cleaners to remain on the surface. Prolonged contact with these products will alter surface finishes and void the warranty.
